COVID-19 patients at home with persistent health problems - Biomax supports data analysis of a previously unrecognized patient group

Planegg, Germany, 18 June 2020 - The bioinformatics company Biomax, based in Planegg near Munich, Germany, is working in cooperation with CIRO, a Dutch treatment and knowledge centre for lung diseases, and the Dutch Patient organization for lung patients, Longfonds, on an in-depth data analysis of COVID-19 patients with persistent symptoms.

Many patients with suspected COVID-19 who have never been hospitalized for treatment complain of permanent symptoms. About 13,5000 patients with COVID-19-like symptoms have joined a Dutch Facebook group and almost 2,000 of these answered a questionnaire on symptoms, quality of life and much more within only four days. According to Michael Rutgers, head of the Dutch Patient Organisation for Lung Patients, the first evaluation of the questionnaires showed that the health of many corona patients who stayed at home was still "frighteningly bad" even after months. The profound analysis of these data by experts from CIRO and Biomax will now provide detailed insights into this patient group, which has so far been virtually ignored.
